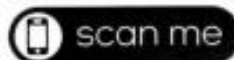

STEPS TO SEE A SAIP COUNSELLOR AT KAMLOOPS SEXUAL ASSAULT COUNSELING CENTRE

Step 1

Call us at 250-372-0179 and speak with our Intake worker for about 10 minutes to gather basic information. You can do this with a trusted adult or by yourself.

Step 2

You will be booked for an in person Assessment with a SAIP counsellor. This takes about an hour. If you're 12 or older, usually, you don't need parental permission to access services. If you're 12 and under, a parent/guardian will need to sign consent forms.

Step 3

After your assessment you may be put on the waitlist for up to 3 months. We will call you to book your first appointment.

Step 4

You will meet with your counsellor every 2 weeks to explore safety, boundaries, consent, identifying feelings, coping skills, and practicing grounding work.
